For the new academic year (September 2018 – May 2019) our Greek School offers the following programs:

**(1) Tuesday evening classes (4:45 – 7:00 pm) for children ages 4 to 15.**

- Our students are placed in **language acquisition levels** according to their language proficiency and age, in order to learn more effectively.
- Our focus is on **conversation**.
- Our **teaching staff** is highly educated and enthusiastic. In a warm and friendly environment our students learn the **Greek language and Greek – orthodox tradition**.
- Our program also offers practice in **Greek dancing**.
- **New series of books** is going to be used with **access to a digital platform** for children to practice and learn in a more enjoyable way at school and home.

**(2) Thursday evening classes of Greek for Adults / Adolescents**

**Two semesters (15 classes each semester):**

**(1<sup>st</sup> semester) September – January; (2<sup>nd</sup> semester) February - May**

**Levels:** (1) Beginners / Advanced Beginners (6:15 – 7:30 PM)

(2) Intermediate / Advanced (7:45 – 9:00 PM)

- This is a program for those who want to **learn** or **improve** their Greek.
- The focus is on **conversational modern Greek** and involves the students in conversation in a variety of social situations in a friendly atmosphere.

Early registration secures enrollment and helps us plan and prepare for the new academic year in terms of teaching staff, material and language acquisition levels. Therefore, if you plan to register in any one of our programs, please fill out the appropriate registration form and return it to the Church Office with a check of the registration fee before August 20<sup>th</sup>.
